Letter of Intent Guidelines

Our goal in requesting pre-proposals is to explore novel research ideas prior to eliciting full proposals from selected applicants.

All pre-proposals must follow the formatting guidelines described below. Pre-proposals that do not adhere to the formatting guidelines will not be reviewed. Pre-proposals should fit on 8.5" x 11" paper, be single-spaced and use 11-point Arial font. Submit the application as a single PDF document.

PAGE 1

- 1. Grant title**
- 2. Principal investigator**
 - Name
 - Institutional affiliation and contact information (address, email, and telephone)
 - i. Include co-investigator information in addendum (see below)
- 3. Type of application**
 - Write whether it is a pilot (12 month) project or established investigator (24 month) grant. Pilot projects do not require preliminary data. Established investigator projects require preliminary data.
- 4. Investigator qualifications (200 words or less)**
 - Describe your experience in the field of vascular/lymphatic anomalies and qualifications that are relevant to the proposed research.

PAGE 2

- 1. Lymphatic anomaly type(s) to be investigated**
 - List the lymphatic anomalies that will be studied in the project or the lymphatic anomalies that are related to the proposed research. *The LMI will only consider applications that include generalized lymphatic anomaly, kaposiform lymphangiomatosis, central conducting lymphatic anomaly, or Gorham-Stout disease in this section.*
- 2. Hypothesis and specific aims/objectives**
 - State the central hypothesis and specific aims of the project.
